SOW & GROW

JUNE 21–25 • JULY 26–30

Sow & Grow campers will grow and tend plants while learning about nutrition and healthy eating. They will gain an appreciation for the importance of plants as they use them to create colorful and delicious meals.

WATER WAYS

JUNE 28–JULY 2

Water Ways campers will investigate the health of our bayous and other bodies of water. They will identify and observe the inhabitants of aquatic environments such as turtles in our ponds and herons fishing along the bayou. All will explore the role of water in our lives and our ecosystems.

CREATE IN NATURE

JULY 5–9 • AUGUST 9–13

Create in Nature campers will unleash their innate creativity and allow nature to inspire their art. They will paint, draw, sculpt, tell stories, create music, and dance, using nature as a backdrop.

POTIONS & PROVISIONS

JULY 12–16

Potions & Provisions campers will explore several aspects of ethnobotany, the study of using plants for traditional medicine. Campers will locate and sample local edible plants and learn to identify harmful species. They will also create their own plant extracts.

BIRDS OF THE BAYOU

JULY 19–23

Birds of the Bayou campers will learn about our avian friends, beginning with locating and identifying birds in various habitats. Campers will investigate how and what birds eat. They will crack the secrets of migration and learn how birds survive in extreme situations.

ECOSYSTEM ADVENTURES

AUGUST 2–6

Ecosystem Adventures campers will become junior explorers and do-it-yourself pioneers. They will practice survival skills, from finding food and clean water to creating serviceable shelters to basic first aid. They will identify local edible plants and discover which can be used in medical emergencies.
