

Partners in Progress

Wildlife Habitat Federation

Sowed two rounds of cover crops, September 2019 and May 2020, in Coastal Prairie to prepare soil and planted native grasses in September 2020.



Texas A&M AgriLife Extension's Texas Community Watershed Partners

Approximately 100 volunteers helped plant more than 12,000 aquatic plants in 2.2-acre Stormwater Wetlands adjacent to Sims Bayou meander from July-November 2020.



Trees for Houston

Planting approximately 1,200 trees for reforestation, including hundreds grown in our on-site tree farm.



Houston Audubon

Conducting monthly first-Thursday bird count and monitoring bluebird boxes.


